WINDOWS 95 AND 98

- Load Windows Explorer.
- Click on the **Tools** menu.
- Click on **Folder Options**.
- Click on the **File Types** tab.
- Click on **New**.
- Type **CCS** in the **File Extension** text box.
- Click on **OK**.
- Click on **Change**.
- Click on **Select the program from a list**.
- Click on **OK**.
- Click on **Browse** and browse for the file **C:\CCSWIN\SYSTEM\CCS.EXE**.
- Click on **Open**.
- Click on **OK**.
- Click on **Close**.

WINDOWS 2000
